



**Mrs. Dominique Ouattara, the First Lady of Côte d'Ivoire, Patron of the maiden flight of Air France's Airbus 380 to Abidjan**

- On January 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014 a fantastic flight in a A380 to Abidjan

On the occasion of the International Investment Forum in Côte d'Ivoire of which she is a partner, Air France will serve Abidjan by Airbus A380, exceptionally.

The world's largest commercial aircraft will land for the first time in Côte d'Ivoire and in West Africa, on January 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014.
